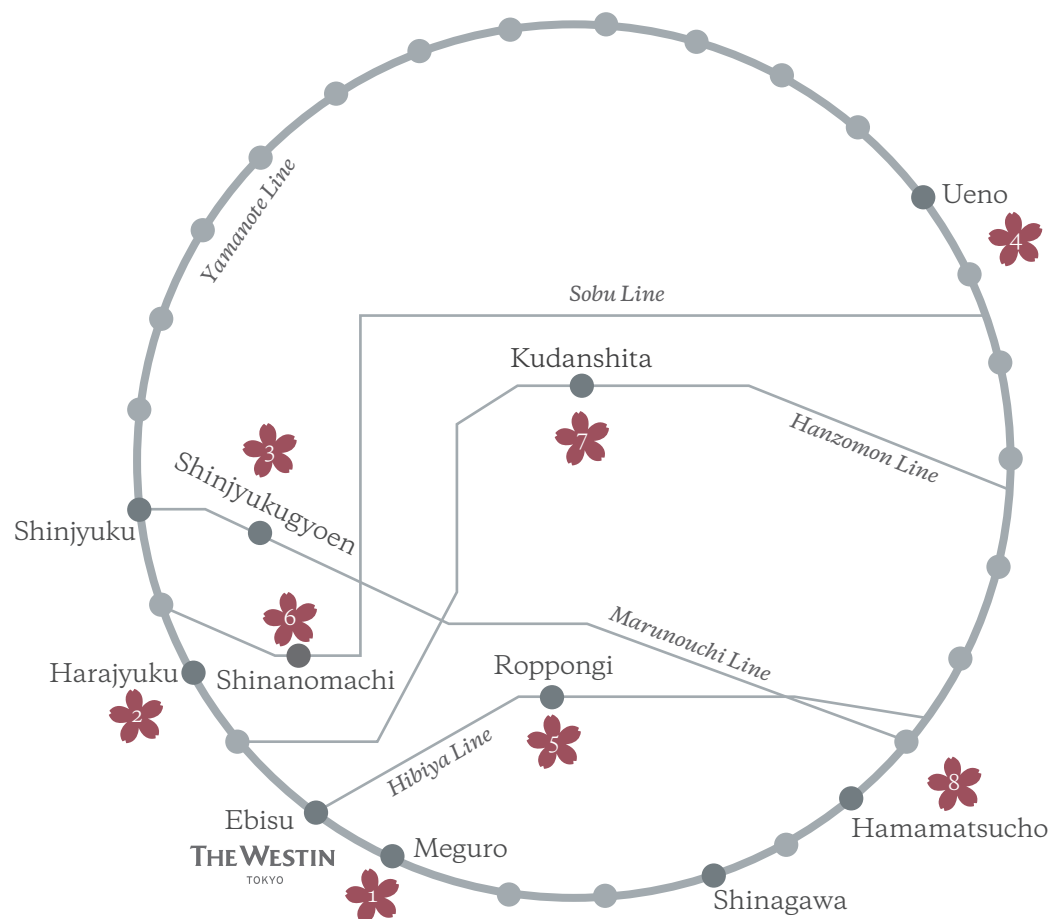


THE WESTIN TOKYO

Meguro River

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Meguro Station (3 minutes). 5 minutes' walk from Meguro Station.

Along both sides of the river banks spanning 4km, you will find 800 Somei Yoshino cherries in bloom. At night, they are illuminated.



Yoyogi Park

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Harajuku Station (5 minutes). 3 minutes' walk from Harajuku Station.

Atop the vast lawn, you will find cherry trees in full bloom. This is a popular cherry blossom viewing location.



Shinjyuku Gyoen National Park

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Shinjuku Station. From Shinjuku Station, board the Tokyo Metro Marunouchi Line and take it to Shinjuku-gyoenmae Station (3 minutes). 5 minutes' walk from Shinjuku-gyoenmae Station.

Enjoy 1,300 cherry trees of 65 varieties outbloom.



Ueno Onshi Park

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Ueno Station (30 minutes). 2 minutes' walk from the Ueno Park exit of Ueno Station.

The main road through the park features 1,200 cherry trees, making it one of the foremost destinations in Tokyo.

Tokyo Midtown

Take the Tokyo Metro Hibiya Line from Ebisu Station to Roppongi Station (6 minutes). 6 minutes' walk from Roppongi Station. When in full bloom, sakura street is turned to sakura tunnel. At night, their illuminated blossoms create a bewitching mood.

Meiji Jingū Gaien

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Yoyogi Station (8 minutes). From Yoyogi Station, take the JR Sobu Line to Sendagaya Station (2 minutes). 10 minutes' walk from Sendagaya Station.

The pedestrian walkway has 500 cherry trees in a row. Each varietal has a different blooming point, so you can enjoy the way they gradually bloom in succession.

Chidorigafuchi Ryokudo Park

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Shibuya Station (2 minutes). From Shibuya Station, take the Tokyo Metro Hanzomon Line to Hanzomon Station (12 minutes). 6 minutes' walk from Hanzomon Station.

The promenade which 260 cherry trees are in full bloom, making you feel as if you are strolling through a tunnel of flowers.

Hama-Rikyu Gardens

Take the JR Yamanote Line from Ebisu Station to Hamamatsucho Station (15 minutes). 15 minutes' walk from Hamamatsucho Station.

As you cross the bridge spanning the pond, you can enjoy the water to see the reflections of cherry blossoms in full bloom.
